Comedy about the lives and loves of four quirky 16-year-old girls who play on the same school football team and live on the same inner city estate. We join them on their bumpy journey through adolescence taking in boys, sex, cliques, teachers, heartbreak, fun and even some football along the way.



At the heart of the comedy is Viva (Adelayo Adedayo), whose ambition is to "stay motivated" and concentrate on getting a good career. In the meantime she's happy analysing her less sensible friends and helping them through the many pitfalls of teen life. She lives with her dad Rob (Colin Salmon), who is "hot for an old guy", her annoying brother Jamie, and her stepmother Anna (Dolly Wells), a New Zealander who also happens to be Viva's sadistic school PE teacher.



Viva is great friends with Holli (Natasha Jonas), whose entertaining violent outbursts are legendary. Sarcastic Saz (Mandeep Dhillon) and dizzy Amber (Alice Felgate) complete the gang. They talk about everything from history homework to their ambitions in life. They share everything: their clothes, their moods, their secrets and - occasionally - their mothers' tranquillisers.
