With his release from prison, Emily considers confronting the person who destroyed her childhood, as she seeks to find out if his time in prison has changed him.

Emily reaches out to those from her childhood teachers, family friends and her mother - trying to understand how her abuse remained hidden for so long.

It's an emotional portrayal of the effects of long-term abuse, showing the importance of confronting our past, and the power of speaking up. Emily's story is a testament to the resilience of the human spirit and the need to support survivors of abuse.
