



Emotional interviews from the family members and friends of the gravely injured teens highlight what they believe happened that night, but the only ones who know the true story are those who were in the car. As their stories change, conflicting testimonies emerge and rumours spread amongst the community – it's down to the police to unpick the mystery of what really went on that night. With the critical hard evidence and real truths finally eked out, almost a year to the day after the crash, the truth is finally revealed.





Janis went along to help get Lucy settled in, planning to be there for three weeks. She ended up living with Lucy on a jungle island for eight years.
